Noise is related directly to our daily lives and the cause of noise is varied. In 1990, people's [26] complaints about noise constituted nearly 30 percent of all complaints made to local public organizations. There are various [27] factors which (a) to noise pollution. The kinds of noise that bother [28] neighbors, such as the noise from restaurants, *karaoke* music from bars which are open very late at night, and the noise from air conditioners and loudspeakers are increasing significantly. These account for about 40 percent of all complaints about noise. They create a serious noise pollution problem.

Those living in crowded housing developments or condominiums in urban areas are (b) to listen to various kinds of noise such as traffic and neighborhood noise. You should pay close attention to sources of noise from your neighbors when you decide to rent or buy a condominium or apartment. After having lived in your chosen location for a while, you will surely begin to be bothered by the noise from air conditioners and water heaters on your neighbors' verandas. Builders seem to think that putting noise sources outside rooms will reduce the noise, but this actually increases noise pollution. Even if people are not consciously bothered so much by low levels of noise, the brain unconsciously hears it and this sometimes causes [29] irritation.

An increasing number of people living near construction work on subways complain that the noise and vibration, caused by the construction work, (c) their sleep and inflict a great deal of stress and suffering on them.

Another example is noise pollution caused by military jet aircraft. The Atsugi and Yokota U.S. Air Bases are located in the middle of residential quarters in the Tokyo metropolitan area. So the [30] excessive noise made by warplanes' taking off and landing at night is causing [31] unbearable suffering to nearby residents. Atsugi City has made strong [32] representations to the U.S. Forces to take steps to reduce the number of low-flying planes over the City, Again Osaka Airport is also situated in the middle of Itami City and local people have been so harassed by the loud noise of jet planes that at one time they went to the Osaka High Court to ask for a total ban on night flying. However, the Court turned down their demand. The Japanese government should think about the sufferings experienced by these people and do its [33] utmost to restore peace and quiet at night.
